## VCE Update

The GAT has been rescheduled to **Thursday 12 August 2021**.

The rescheduling of the GAT allows schools time to organise logistics and put COVIDSafe protocols in place, so that students and staff can return onsite to participate safely.

<u>Consideration of Educational Disadvantage (CED)</u>: VCAA will again use the CED process to finalise VCE results.

The CED process accounts for the disruption to student learning caused by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. It applies to every student completing one or more VCE or scored VCE VET Unit 3 – 4 sequences in 2021 (including Year 11 and 10 students).

#### 2021 VCE Examination Timetable

VCAA has released the 2021 VCE examination timetable. All students must read the VCAA examination rules for VCE and the GAT. It is also their responsibility to be familiar with materials and equipment authorised for use in the GAT and VCE written examinations.

## **NCCD Data Collection**

As you may have been aware, every year Darul Ulum College of Victoria participates in the NCCD Data Collection process whereby the school is mandated to submit to the Australian government the total number of students that have been identified as needing support for disability for the different categories and level of adjustments that students have been supported with at Darul Ulum College of Victoria during the current census year. This is normally done during the second week of August each year.

Students are de-identified and names are not submitted for the count purpose. The information is then used by the government to determine the funding load received by the school. This will further help the school to review their learning and support systems and processes as well as helps school to continuously improve education outcomes for all students. 
## **Activities of Foundation Students**




