**RE: Continuing with the Staggered Return to Onsite Learning for Week Starting:  
Monday 8 November until Friday 19 November**

I write to update you on the school's plan regarding the staggered return to onsite learning.

Upon further meticulous review and assessment of the current situations and considering the rising number of confirmed cases among students within the last week, it was deemed necessary by the school's management to continue with the staggered return schedule for another two weeks at least.

There is certainly no substitute for onsite learning, however, in evaluating the current trend, it is inevitable that many more classes will be sent into quarantine, resulting in further interruptions to students' learning. Needless to state that it would be wiser to have students attending onsite on some weekdays as opposed to being in quarantine for 7 – 14 days.

The case numbers among students will be reviewed within the next fortnight and parents will be notified of the school's operations for the week starting Monday 22 November.

Please refer to the attached Students' Attendance Schedule for the next fortnight.

A courtesy reminder to parents that the quarantine period for students who are 12 years and over will be determined based on the student's vaccination status. The Department of Health has issued a directive stating that fully vaccinated students who need to quarantine will only need to do so for 7 days whereas the quarantine period for partially or non-vaccinated students is 14 days.

Parents of vulnerable children or children of workers who cannot be supervised at home when they are not scheduled for onsite learning may send their children to school on those days. Please email the school's Case Officer for record keeping purposes. The email is:

Please note that students who need to quarantine must remain at home for their quarantine period whether they are classified as being vulnerable or otherwise.

Students participating in the extra-curricular Hifz classes will continue to participate remotely for the remaining part of this term.
