Dear Parents and Year 9 Students,

2023 Year 10 VCE Accelerated Program Survey

Further to the Year 9 Parent Information Session which was held last term, I write to keep you abreast with our **VCE Accelerated Program** which commences in Year 10, in preparation for your Year 9 child's subject selections next year, Insha'Allah.

By the grace of The All-Mighty, the college has introduced the VCE Accelerated Program for Year 10 students several years ago which has proven to be a significant milestone in maximizing students' results by the end of their VCE journey.

In addition to the standard delivery of the Year 10 curriculum, the VCE Accelerated Program for Year 10 students in 2023 consists of subjects outlined in the three blocks below.

Students will be required to select one out of the two subjects in each one of the three blocks. Enrolment in the accelerated subjects is dependent on each student's current performance and Year 9 semester reports.

Students are generally approved to be enrolled in the accelerated subjects if they are achieving 70% or above in their Year 9 Science and / or Maths subjects. However, conditional enrolment in the accelerated subjects can be considered where a student scores lower, subject to the student's aptitude, work habits and the VCE Review Committee's approval.

All Year 9 students are required to complete the 2023 Year 10 Accelerated Program Survey by filling in the link below. The due date for completing this survey is **Wednesday 19 October**.
